Wailoa Sculpture Garden Guidelines

1. The committee is considering selecting individual pieces from separate artists or a body of work from one artist. All artwork must have been created in the last 3 years.
2. Artist is solely responsible for the installation, safety and deinstallation of their work.
3. Wailoa Center has a right of refusal should the sculpture change significantly from the original proposal or it is found to be unsafe at or before installation.
4. The fastening bolt pattern embedded in the foundation was standardized: 4, 1/2" bolts, 16" +/- 1/2" on center in a square. It is up to the artist to make the final measurements for their respective installation site(s).
5. The embedded fastening bolts can not be cut, modified or altered. Please consult with Wailoa Center or HIAA if you need assistance.
6. Installations must be scheduled and attended by a staff member of Wailoa Center or HIAA.
7. Physical height not to exceed 5', width not to exceed 2' in diameter at the bases and 3' otherwise from center. The sculpture should not be top heavy.
8. The black cinder can be contoured per the artist's vision. The black cinder should cover the exposed cement foundation.
